Prior to July 2000, Mr. Pelletier spent nine years as Controller and subsequently Vice President of Finance at AverStar Inc., a software company that provided ngineering and software services, products/tools and integrated system solutions to government and commercial customers, and eleven years at Textron, Inc. in various accounting and finance roles. He holds a BA in Accounting from the University of Rhode Island, and an MBA from Sentley College.
n connection with his appointment as Principal Accounting Officer and Executive Director of Finance, Mr. Pelletier received an option to burchase 15,000 shares of the Company s Common Stock, at an exercise price of \$8.69 per share, vesting in equal installments over 5 years from the date of grant. He also received an increase in base salary from \$167,745 to \$184,519.
