Item 1.01 Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement

As announced in our media release attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1, on February 22, 2006, Advanced Power Technology, Inc. (APT) entered into a license agreement with the Electronic Systems sector of Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation (Northrop) in which Northrop will license their silicon carbide technology to APT, and APT will be the exclusive foundry supplier of certain silicon carbide products to Northrop. In addition, the agreement allows APT to use the licensed technology to manufacture and sell other silicon carbide products for commercial purposes. Royalties will be due to Northrop upon the sale of such products to customers other than Northrop. The contract is effective until the expiration of the last to expire of the patents included in the agreement, unless the agreement is extended by the parties.
