- (1) Common shares issued upon vesting of performance units granted under the Cincinnati Bell Inc. 2007 Long Term Incentive Plan, which is a Rule 16b-3 plan.
- (2) Surrender of common shares to cover tax liabilities upon vesting of performance units.
- (3) Option shares granted under the Cincinnati Bell Inc. 2007 Long Term Incentive Plan which is a Rule 16b-3 Plan.
- (4) Cash-settled Stock Appreciation Right (SAR) granted under the Cincinnati Bell Inc. 2007 Long Term Incentive Plan which is a Rule 16b-3 Plan.

(5) On January 27, 2012, the reporting person was granted a cash-settled Stock Appreciation Right (SAR) as to 129,870 common shares. The SAR vests in three installments based on the Company's satisfaction of certain performance criteria for the fiscal years ending December 31, 2012, 2013 and 2014. The performance criteria for 2013 were met, resulting in the vesting of another 32,468 of the shares underlying the SAR.

(6) On January 30, 2013, the reporting person was granted 95,511 options. The options vest in three installments based on the Company's satisfaction of certain performance criteria for the fiscal years ending December 31, 2013, 2014 and 2015. The performance criteria for 2013 were met, resulting in the vesting of 46,180 of the options.
