- (3) credited in respect of the performance-based restricted stock units granted to the reporting person on January 19, 2017 will vest if issuer satisfies financial performance criteria for the three-year performance period ending January 31, 2020. Dividend equivalent units credited in respect of such performance-based restricted stock units that are not eligible for conversion at the end of such performance period will be cancelled.
