(1) Each phantom stock unit is the economic equivalent of one share of Chevron Corporation common stock. The phantom stock units are payable in cash upon vesting. On December 6, 2013, one-half of the reporting person's original grant (plus the accrued dividend equivalents) vested and were settled in cash. The remaining one-half of the grant (plus accrued dividend equivalents) vested on December 6, 2015 and were settled in cash.

(2) Between November 27, 2014 and December 4, 2015, the reporting person acquired 630 shares of Chevron Common Stock under the Chevron Employee Savings Investment Plan, a 401(k) plan.
